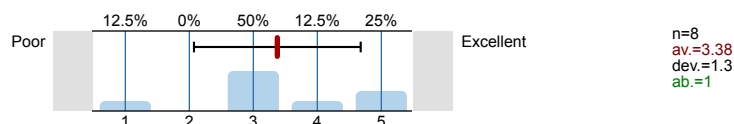
- It was difficult to understand some of the more complicated elements of the course. I can't say for certain if it was due to Professor Plott, but it seemed he had trouble relating topics to us.

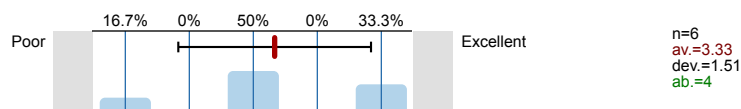

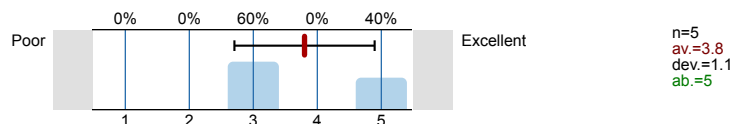
